

Insurance Info

The JEFA club insurance on the Diamond DA40, N505JF, is by Avemco. It applies to the Diamond when the aircraft is in flight by a pilot who holds a currently effective Pilot Certificate (unless a pre-solo student pilot) issued by the FAA. It protects both plane and flying club members who:

1. Possess Private, Commercial, or Airline Transport Pilot certificate
2. Have a current and effective Medical Certificate
3. Satisfies the FAA's flight review requirements
4. Has at least 100 hours of total logged flying time, of which not less than 3 hours is in the insured aircraft
5. Has at least 3 hours logged pilot time in the same make and model in the preceding 180 days, or had taken and passed a currency check-out in and written approval from a CFI in the proceeding 45 days
6. Has received a check-out from, and written approval of, a CFI who has successfully completed the Diamond DA-40/G1000 Transition Pilot Training Course conducted by Empire Aviation, Delmar Smith, or Amy Gray

The DA40 coverages are as follows:

The JEFA club insurance on the Cessna 172SP, N2477J, is by Avemco. It applies to the Cessna when the aircraft is in flight by a pilot who holds a currently effective Pilot Certificate (unless a pre-solo student pilot) issued by the FAA. It protects both plane and flying club members who:

1. Have a current and effective Medical Certificate (unless pre-solo student pilot)
2. Satisfies the FAA's flight review requirements
3. Has received a check-out from, and written approval of, a CFI in the same make and model of aircraft
