**Local Club Notes:**

\* Based on 50 hours Hobbs time for a Private Pilot certificate at a rate of \$86 per hour for the aircraft and \$35 an hour for instructor for "Dual", including pre and post flight.

\*\* Membership dues are \$35.00/Month, estimated for 6 months.

**JEFA Notes:**

\*\*\* Based on 50 hours Hobbs time (1.0 hour Hobbs = ~.7 hours Tach time) for a Private Pilot certificate at a rate of \$85 per hour for the aircraft and \$20 an hour for instructor for "Dual", including pre and post flight.

\*\*\*\* Membership dues are \$20.00/Month only if 0 hrs. of flight time are accrued for the month.
